CLARA FANTINI

Clara Fantini was born in Genoa and studied painting in Rome at the State Institute of Applied Arts. Since 1985, she has lived and worked in Kavala, Greece. Since 1992, her work has been presented in solo and group exhibitions in Greece and internationally, including Milan, London, Paris, Rome, Shanghai, and Munich.

"My painting is a continuous process of subtraction. I seek the essence of the human form by stripping away detail until only the core remains. I aim to capture what is not immediately visible, allowing viewers to discover their own narrative within the work.

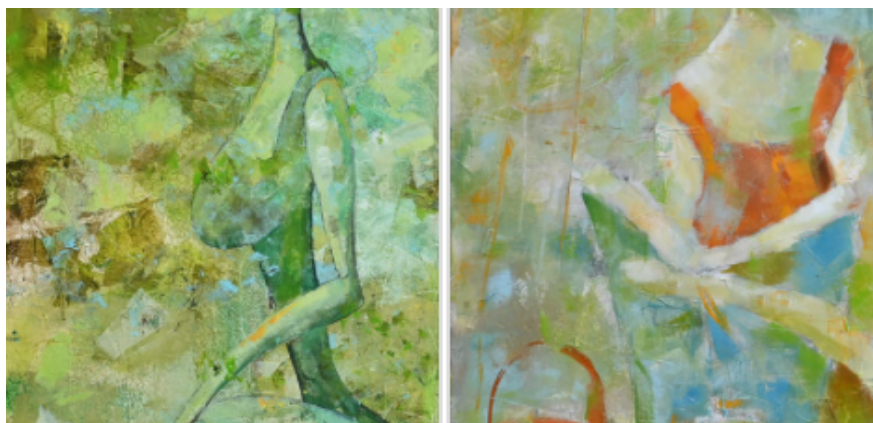
I am drawn to contrasts: acid greens against deep reds, or near-incorporeal figures emerging from heavy, textured backgrounds. Within this tension, I find balance. I paint to approach reality as I experience it, not as I see it, allowing a chance to reveal a more essential, hidden truth."

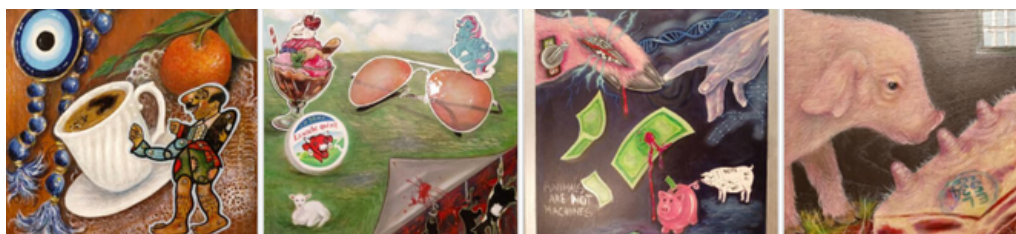

Donna – The Quiet Strength is not a portrait, but a gathering of feminine presences, emotions and inner states. Each woman carries her own story, yet together they form one shared emotional landscape – a reminder that true strength does not always need to be loud. Sometimes it is found in the stillness of simply remaining true to oneself.

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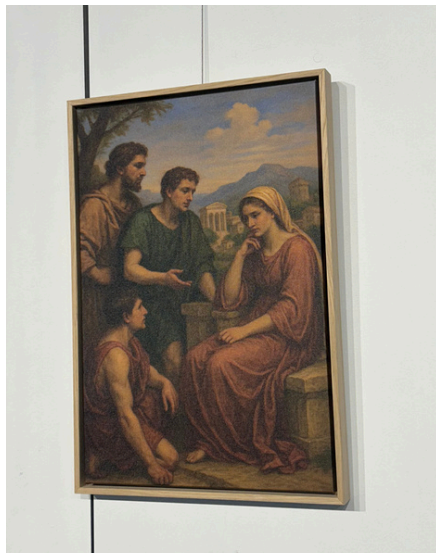


Sven Gutker de Geus

Christina Soulioti

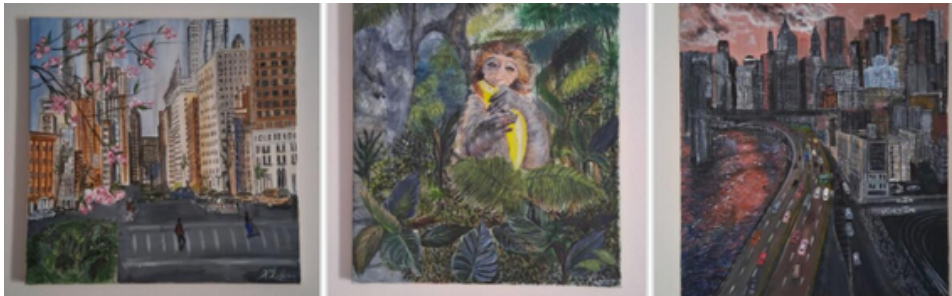

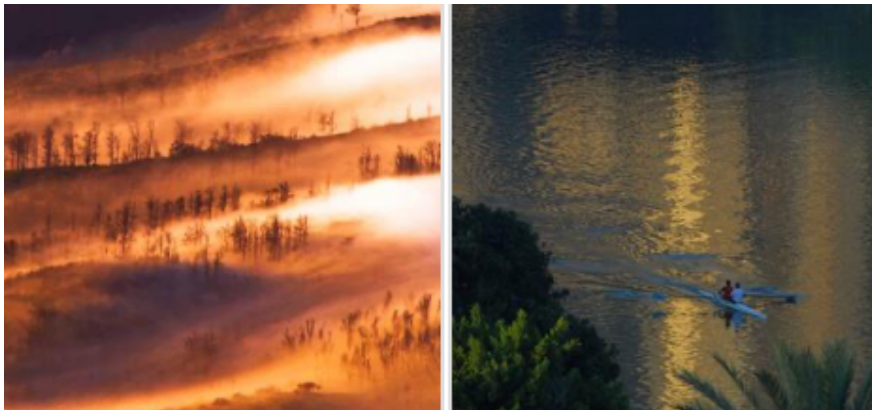

Andreas Kentis is a wildlife photographer from Cyprus, with a particular passion for birds and the natural world. His creative background also extends to theatre and acting, but for him creativity is not defined by a single medium. Whether portraying a character on stage, capturing a fleeting moment of a wild bird, or simply making something with his own hands, the joy lies in the experience of creating and in what remains afterwards as evidence of that moment.

Photography in nature, however, is where he feels most truly present. He believes that nature itself is the greatest form of art, and that the sun simply reveals it to us, again and again, with every dawn. His camera is merely a way of preserving a memory of what nature allowed him to witness.

Eleni Orfanoudaki

“Face to Face”

Orphanoudaki's artistic practice explores the identity of youth culture in Cyprus and presents it to the viewer through her own perspective. More specifically, she photographs young individuals whose personal expression belongs to a more alternative culture and is strongly connected to aspects of the artist's own identity.

Orphanoudaki creates portraits that focus on the gaze and inner world of each subject. Through research and documentation combined with photography, the artist brings to the surface the stories and lived experiences of her subjects, which form an integral part of their personal identity. Written across everyone's face are phrases that emerged through informal interviews between the models and the artist.

Through these confessions, which appear like marks upon the skin, the words of the individuals are visualized. Existing harmoniously alongside the photographic image, these elements place the viewer in a process of exploration and understanding of the person before them.

Issues of gender, sexuality, race, self-expression, adaptation, struggle, and belonging are themes that affect each of the subjects. The artist seeks to bridge understanding between the viewer and the artwork, while exploring the need for expressing one's personal truth.
