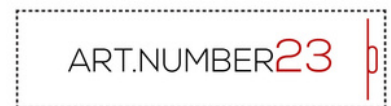

Lara Melachrinou was born and raised in Athens, where painting, color, and design became a natural language of expression from an early age. She studied Interior Architecture at AKTO, earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts from Middlesex University in London, and completed a Master's Degree in Interior Design at Florence Design Academy.

Alongside her artistic practice, Lara works professionally as an Interior Architect and Designer, with recognition and a strong presence in the design field. Her experience with space, light, materials, and composition continuously influences her artistic vision. In parallel, she develops her painting practice and participates in exhibitions in Greece and abroad.

Her work moves between cubism and abstraction, exploring structure, freedom, emotion, and self-discovery. She also leads creative Action Painting workshops for children, encouraging spontaneity, imagination, and joy through art.

In 2014, her painting San Francisco won the BIC Design on Fire Competition, selected from over 40,300 European submissions. She has since sold more than 50 original paintings internationally.

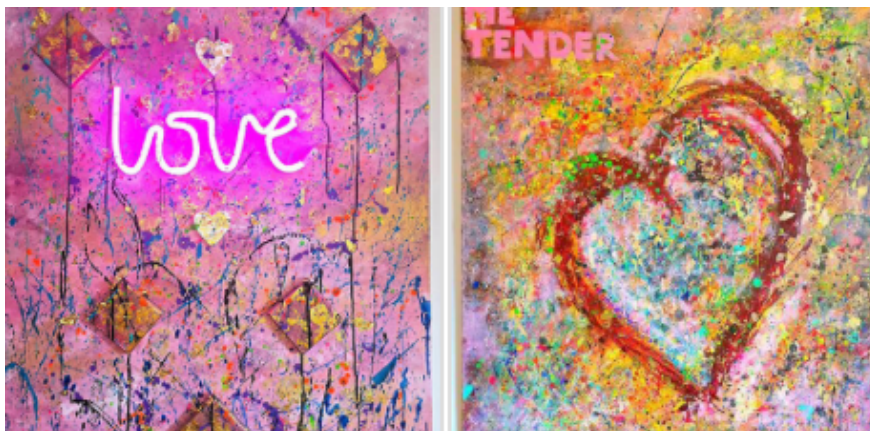

Anna Manga

I am a visual artist with an academic background in Art Conservation of works of art, Art History and Public History (Msc) and I live in Athens Greece. I create mixed media works on 220 gr paper, combining archival ink fine pens with collage elements from newspapers and museums ephemera. My work involves a technique I call "spiral tsiki", an homage to Alexis Akritchakis, including forms of literary fragments and hand written notes and song lyrics. Each work functions as a daily diary entry-mood of the day- captured through the rhythmic, repetitive motion of the fine pens on paper combined with hand torn newspapers and museum ephemera. It is a very personal, diary-like intimacy, an internal monologue.

Ez Naive is the virtual identity of Elli Zogia, a Greek artist based in so called Vancouver, Canada where she creates on the traditional, unceded, and ancestral lands of the Coast Salish peoples, including the territories of the Musqueam, Squamish, and Tsleil-Waututh Nations.

Elli's work explores rich themes of intersectionality and magical realism, balancing activism with escapism. With a focus on social justice, queerness, and sexuality, she invites viewers to reflect on their own narratives through her art.

Drawing inspiration from raw emotion and folk art, Elli enjoys playing with texture and symbolism in her figurative illustrations. While most of her work is digital, she values traditional techniques, particularly the art of lino cutting, and incorporates tactile qualities into her creations.

Through Ez Naive, Elli aims to provoke thought and spark meaningful conversations, using visual storytelling to connect with others.

Nadia Russ (Mirth)

Nadia Russ (Mirth) is the Ukrainian-born Russian artist, living in NYC (USA) via Bahamas. In 1989, in Moscow, she created NeoPopRealism style of visual arts, which concept in a few words is to use the flowing line to create the shapes, divide the shapes into sections, and filling those sections with unique repetitive patterns. All that must involve imagination, subconsciousness, intuition. Nadia's first art exhibit was in Moscow's Manege (1990). Later, she exhibited artwork worldwide, and has it in various collections, including museums. In Bahamas (1997), her work gained brightness. In USA, Nadia authored several NeoPopRealism instructional books, available internationally, including at Amazon. July 2026, she stopped using name "Russ", when signing her creations, in protest of endless wars worldwide. Her new name is Nadia Mirth. The "NeoPopRealism in Education", ISBN: 9798997547806, is her first book, signed Nadia Mirth, since then. It was published August 8, 2026, and available internationally.

“The way of an artist is an entirely different way. It is a way of surrender.”

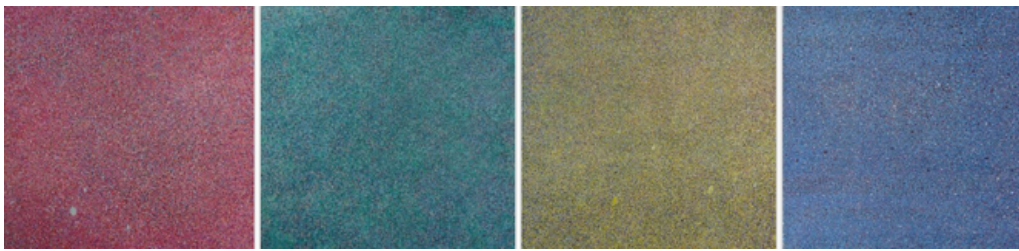
Anastasiadou Chrisy was born in Serres, Greece.

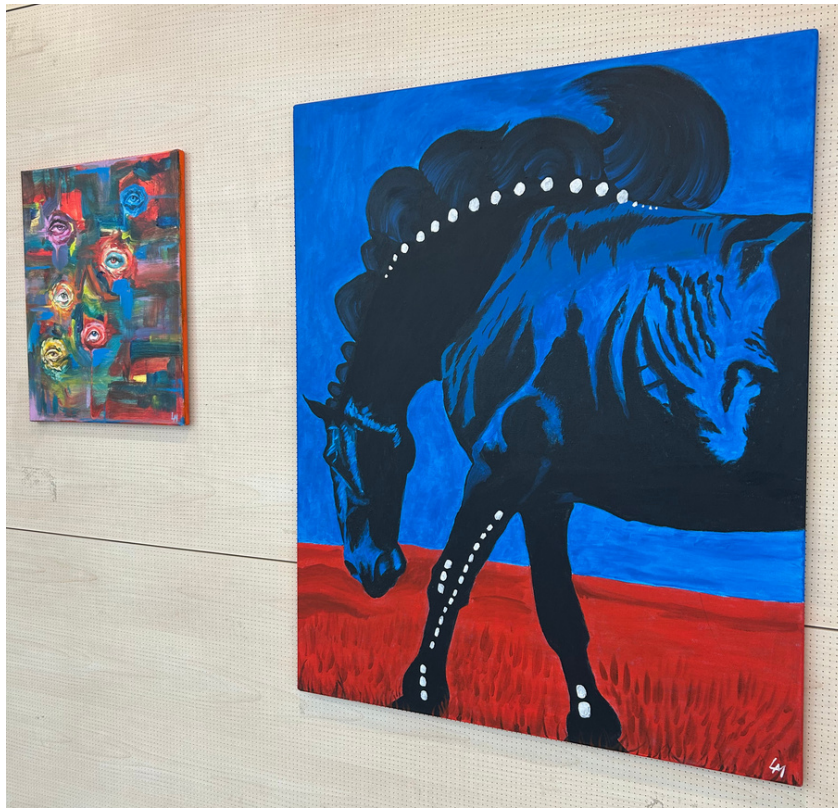

He then attended the Department of Architecture and Engineering of the University of Thessaly, where he completed his postgraduate studies. From his first steps in painting, he explored a wide range of themes and materials, working on wood, canvas, paper and fabric, using charcoal, pencil, oil and acrylics. His artistic career has evolved from the depiction of landscapes and figures to more abstract and multi-layered compositions. He is interested in the relationship between material and sensation, and examines painting not only as a means of representation but as a process of dialogue with the material, space and the viewer. At the same time, he uses photography as a tool for capturing the moment and the composition, without treating it as a final work but as a starting point or reflection. His work is now characterized by the freedom of abstract expression, the experimental use of color, and the willingness to question the limits of representation, creating works that invite the viewer to an experiential and personal reading.
